- The SAM2 machine records data of speeding vehicles, the Council will download this monthly, analyse the data and any significant issues will be reported to the police.
- Highways have advised the placing of speed limit repeater signs along Bungay Road; the Council have applied for match funding to undertake this project in the spring.
