DRAFT MINUTES of the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 25 July 2022 at 7.00 pm at Scole Community Centre, Ransome Avenue, Scole.

- 1. To consider accepting apologies for absence: Apologies for absence were received and approved from Cllr J Brewer and Cllr R Buckenham.
- 2. To co-opt Gillian Blakesley to the current vacant position of Parish Councillor: Cllr Blakelsey gave a brief presentation on why she would like to join the Council. Councillors voted unanimously to co-opt Gillian Blakesley. Cllr Blakesley signed the Acceptance of Office and joined the meeting.
- 3. To approve the minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 27 June 2022: The minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on 27 June 2022 (pages 1-5 of 5) previously circulated to all members, were proposed for approval by Cllr Blakesley seconded Cllr Trevail and unanimously agreed.

- Email from the River Waveney Trust regarding "working together"
- Email from South Norfolk regarding Tree Wardens, it was felt it was not necessary for Scole to have a designated tree warden.
- Quotation to replace the damaged streetlight on Clements Close has been received from Westcotec £1,750.00. Clerk to investigate if this can be claimed on insurance.

9. To receive an update on the progress of the Scole Parish Hub:

- **9.1. To receive an update on the Agreement for Lease and Lease** Still waiting for lawyers to return.
- 9.2. To receive an update on the Scole Parish Hub on lowering the ketb at the entrance to the new Parish Hub:
 - Broadleaf (the developer) have confirmed that the Council should approach South Norfolk for permission to lower the footpath at the entrance to the Scole Parish Hub. It is believed that the entrance is on the original plans **Cllr Ward will look at plans**.
 - Councillors' raised concerns over the unfinished path clerk to speak to Broadleaf.
- 9.3. To consider and approve if appropriate the quotes for the fencing of the land owned by the Parish Council:

Three quotes have been received for various fencing options. In line with the Council's Procurement Policy the decision was taken to use Ian Garnham who will erect a two-rail post and rail fence along the perimeter of the Iand for the Scole Parish Hub, leaving an entrance for the footpath, for the cost of $\pounds1,344.00$. Proposed Cllr McEwen seconded Cllr Fisher and unanimously agreed.

10. To receive an update on the Scole Football Club using \$160 money for improvements to the football pitch:

Waiting for the written quotations from Scole Football Club to submit to South Norfolk Council for approval that S106 money can be used for this project.

11. To receive an update on the installation of a plaque on the south side of Scole Bridge:

The Clerk chased Suffolk County Council, but no response received.

- 12. To discuss the problems with BT/Openreach in the parish and agree a course of action: On several occasions recently the copper cable has been stolen from the parish leaving residents without telephones or internet, Councillors requested the Council write to BT/Openreach to suggest replacing the existing copper cable with fibre and asking why manholes are not locked? Cllr Jones will draft a letter and forward to the Clerk.
- 13. As requested by Cllr Lady Mann, Cllr Brooks, Cllr Blakesley and Cllr Fisher to reconsider the decision previously made regarding the purchase of CCTV cameras at the Scole Pocket Park:

Following the original decision to use solar powered equipment, it is considered the solar panel to support this installation is large and a target for vandalism. Cllr Ward proposed that Option 1 using 2 x leisure batteries to provide power is purchased, seconded Cllr Blakesley and unanimously agreed. The money for this purchase £788.99 will be taken from General Reserves. **Clerk** to place order.
